LECTURE-CUM-INTERACTION

November 1, 2019

Delhi State Centre of The Institution of Engineers (India) organized a Lecture-cum-interaction with TAI and NISTI on November 1, 2019 at Institutions' Premises. Shri Ashok Kulkarni, Expert in Textile and Non Woven delivered a lecture.

Delivering the welcome address in the Inaugural Session, Shri Dinesh Kumar, Chairman, Delhi State Centre-IEI apprised about The Institution of Engineers (India) is the largest multidisciplinary professional body of 9.5 Lakh engineers that encompasses 15 engineering disciplines and gives engineers a global platform from where to share professional interest. Shri Ashok Kulkarni, Expert in Textile and Non Woven delivering the Key-Note address on topic "Non Woven Technology & It's Application". He apprised that Nonwovens find numerous applications ranging from baby diapers to industrial high performance textiles. Some of the important areas where nonwovens are treated as primary alternative for traditional textiles as Geotextiles, materials for building, thermal and sound insulating materials, hygienic and health care textiles and automotive industries. Nonwovens are also used in cover stocks, agriculture, aerospace, home furnishings etc. Further he mentioned that With the nonwovens successfully moving into more technical end-uses, the fiber requirements have also become more important with regard to the fiber properties. The cooperation between fiber supplier and fabric producers is now seen as important criteria for more advancement to come about in the nonwovens field.
