Delhi State Centre of The Institution of Engineers (India) organized **Royal Charters Day** on September 9, 2019 at Institutions' Premises. On this occasion **Shri O P Goel**, Past President, The Institution of Engineers (India) was the Chief Guest of the function.

Delivering the welcome address, **Shri Dinesh Kumar Gill**, Chairman, Delhi State Centre-IEI mentioned about The Institution of Engineers (India) is a first professional body to represent India in several International Bodies, such as the World Mining Congress (WMC), the World Federation of Engineering Organizations (WFEO), the Commonwealth Engineers' Council (CEC), the Federation International du Beton (fib), and the Federation of Engineering Institutions of South and Central Asia (FEISCA).
